10	WHEREAS, bids were solicited for the Madison Valley Drainage Improvement Project, Bid No. 1720:

12	WHEREAS, Escamilla Excavating LLC, was the lowest responsive, responsible bid meeting
13	specifications.
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
15	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
16	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Escamilla Excavating
17	LLC, for the Madison Valley Drainage Improvements Project in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred
18	Eighteen Thousand, Two Hundred Thirty-Seven and 40/100 Dollars (\$218,237.40), which is the base bid
19	amount of One Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand, Nine Hundred Fifty-Two Dollars (\$152,952.00), plus 20%
20	contingencies, and Thirty-Four Thousand, Eight Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars (\$34,695.00) for an
21	additional drainage berm requested by adjacent property owners.
22	Section 2. Funding for this project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating
23	Use Tax Funds and the General Obligation Limited Capital Improvement Bonds as authorized by
24	Resolution No. 14,803.
25	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
26	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
27	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
28	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
29	resolution.
30	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
31	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
