SYNOPSIS	A resolution to authorize the City Manager to execute a contract with McClelland Consulting Engineers, Inc., to provide Design and Engineering Services for the Tri-Creek Greenway Trail Project.	
FISCAL IMPACT	The contract amount is \$249,500.00, funding is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales Tax Funds, Account No. 326459-TS45A21 (\$100,000.00), Transportation Alternative Program Grant Match Fund, Account No. 108129-S10G040 (\$120,000.00), and the 3/8-Cent Capital Trail Improvement Sales Tax Funds, Account No. 326459-TS45A11 (\$29,500.00).

BACKGROUND	Tri-Creek Greenway Trail Plan is a twelve (12)-foot wide trail corridor in the center of City of Little Rock following Rock Creek, Fourche Creek and Brodie Creek from War Memorial Park to Hindman Park. The City of Little Rock was awarded \$3,000,000 in CARTS 2021 Surface Transportation Program Block Grant Funds by the Metroplan Board for this project.	

## BACKGROUND CONTINUED

This section of the project will connect several parks starting in Boyle Park, proceeding south connecting The First Tee, the Little Rock Animal Village, Western Hills Park, Hindman Park and Brodie Park.
