SYNOPSIS FISCAL IMPACT	A resolution to amend Resolution No. 13,709 (June 18, 2023), to authorize the City Manager to enter into a five (5)-year commercial lease extension with World Services for the Blind, for the use of their property located at 2823 South Tyler Street, as a Neighborhood Resource Center. This contract is funded at an annual cost of \$20,000.00, which includes monthly rent in the amount of \$650.00,	
	along with maintenance and routine repairs of the property. Funding for the lease is available from the Housing & Neighborhood Programs General Fund Budget, Account No. 103539-AA0NACP.	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	Since 2013, the City of Little Rock has maintained a partnership with World Services for the Blind, for the use of their property located at 2823 Tyler Street as a Neighborhood Resource Center. The Housing & Neighborhood Programs Code Enforcement occupies the building, which allows the residents of the Oak Forest Community Association access to Code Enforcement Resource Specialists and meeting locations.	

BACKGROUND CONTINUED

On June 18, 2013, the Board of Directors approved Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 13,709, authorizing a ten (10)-year lease, which stated that upon mutual agreement, the initial lease agreement could be extended for an additional five (5) years; this extension represents the additional five (5)-year lease.
