| 11 | WHEREAS, it is critical that the Little Rock Police Department (LRPD) be equipped with reliable |
| 12 | forms of vehicular transportation; and, |
| 13 | WHEREAS, the Little Rock Board of Directors approved Resolution 15,301 (October 6, 2020) for the |
| 14 | execution of a Four (4)-Year Lease Plan utilizing Source-Well Purchasing Agreement (formally NJPA) to |
| 15 | lease up to Fifty-One (51) vehicles from Enterprise FM Trust for a total contract amount not to exceed One |
| 16 | Million, Eight Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand, Two Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$1,855,216.00); and, |
| 17 | WHEREAS, this resolution approves the payment of an Annual Purchase Order (APO) for year two |
| 18 | (2) of the four (4)-year lease plan; and, |
| 19 | WHEREAS, the annual cost for the lease will be Four Hundred Sixty-Three Thousand, Eight Hundred |
| 20 | Four Dollars (\$463,804.00), plus applicable taxes and fees. |
| 21 | NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY |

| 23 | Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to approve an Annual Purchase Order for payment of year |
| 24 | two (2) of the four (4)-year lease plan in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Sixty-Three Thousand, |
| 25 | Eight Hundred Four Dollars (\$463,804.00), plus applicable taxes and fees. |
| 26 | Section 2. The funding for the leased vehicles is available in the Fleet Special Projects Account No. |
| 27 | 108609-72300-S60C471. |
| 28 | Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or |
| 29 | word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or |
| 30 | adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and |
| 31 | effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the |
| 32 | resolution. |
| 33 | Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with |

the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
