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10	WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was issued for an annual purchasing contract to provide automobile		
11	oil and lubricants for use in all City of Little Rock Fleet Units; and,		
12	WHEREAS, three (3) qualified bids were received which met specifications, with Mid-South Sales		
13	submitting the lowest qualifying bid; and,		
14	WHEREAS, the total amount for the annual purchasing contract for oil and lubricants will be One		
15	Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) annually;		
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
17	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
18	Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into an annual		
19	purchase contract with Mid-South Sales for the purchase of automobile oil and lubricants for use in all		
20	City of Little Rock Fleet Units, in an amount of One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars		
21	(\$125,000.00) annually.		
22	Section 2. This Annual Purchase Order will be for one (1)-year, with an option to renew each year		
23	for an additional two (2) years.		
24	Section 3. Funds for this purchase are allocated in the Fleet Services Fuel Account #600013-60310.		
25	Section 4. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or		
26	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
27	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and		
28	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the		
29	resolution.		
30	Section 5. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent		
31	with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
