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3	A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER			
4	INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH DEPAUL USA, INC., TO OPERATE THE			
5	JERICHO WAY HOMELESS DAY RESOURCE CENTER IN AN			
6	AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY THOUSAND			
7	DOLLARS (\$270,000.00); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.			
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9	WHEREAS, the City desires to provide daytime services for homeless individuals and families in the			
10	Central Arkansas area as stated in the Ten (10)-Year Plan to End Chronic Homelessness; and,			
11	WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Proposals ("RFP") for a Homeless Day Resource Center			
12	Services provider (Bid# 14188); and,			
13	WHEREAS, DePaul USA, Inc., ("DePaul") was deemed the lowest cost responsive and responsible			
14	bidder by a review committee; and,			
15	WHEREAS, DePaul is recommended for this contract award;			
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE			
17	CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:			
18	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with DePaul for the			
19	operation of Jericho Way Homeless Day Resource Center to provide services to homeless individuals			
20	and families in the Central Arkansas area, in a form to be approved by the City Attorney, for a term			
21	beginning on or about March 2015 through December 31, 2015 in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred			
22	Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$270,000.00).			
23	Section 2. This contract may be extended for four (4) additional one (1)-year periods upon sufficient			
24	appropriation and mutual agreement of the parties in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Twenty-			
25	Three Thousand, Four Hundred Dollars (\$323,400.00) for the first one (1)-year extension, and in an			
26	amount not to exceed Three Thousand, Four Hundred Dollars (\$323,400.00) plus a cost-of living			
27	(COLA) increase not to exceed 3% for any extensions to operate in year 2017 and thereafter.			
28	Section 3. Funding for these services for the 2015 calendar year will come from the Homelessness			
29	Outreach 15 Account No. S10A436.			
30	Section 4. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or			
31	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or			
32	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and			
33	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of			
34	the resolution.
