NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY 14 15 **OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:** 16 **SECTION 1.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Boyles 17 Construction, Inc., for Marlborough Street Improvements in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred 18 Sixty-One Thousand, Two Hundred Seventy and 20/100 Dollars (\$361,270.20), which is the base bid 19 amount of Three Hundred One Thousand, Fifty-Eight and 50/100 Dollars (\$301,058.50), plus 20% 20 contingencies. 21 SECTION 2. Funding for this project is from the ³/₄-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and 22 Compensating Use Tax Funds and the 2013 Capital Improvements Bonds for Streets and Drainage as 23 authorized by Resolution No. 13,699 and amended by Resolution No. 14,269. 24 SECTION 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, 25 or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or 26 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and 27 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the 28 resolution. 29 SECTION 4. Repealer.
