10	WHEREAS, Bids were solicited for improvements along South Tyler Street from 30 th Street to 32 nd
11	Street, Project No. 13-01-082, Bid No. 16-002; and,
12	WHEREAS, Boyles Construction, Inc., was the lowest responsive, responsible bid meeting
13	specifications.
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
15	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
16	SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Boyles
17	Construction, Inc., for South Tyler Street in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Seventy-Two
18	Thousand, Two Hundred Twenty-Seven and 14/100 Dollars (\$272,227.14), which is the base bid amount
19	of, Two Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand, Eight Hundred Fifty-Five and 95/100 Dollars (\$226,855.95),
20	plus 20% contingencies.
21	SECTION 2. Funding for this project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and
22	Compensating Use Tax Funds and the 2013 Capital Improvements Bonds for Streets and Drainage as
23	authorized by Resolution No. 13,699 and amended by Resolution No. 14,269.
24	SECTION 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase,
25	or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
26	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
27	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
28	resolution.
29	SECTION 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent
30	with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
31	SECTION 5. This resolution will be in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.
