10	WHEREAS, the Fleet Services Department has requested a contract for Allison Rebuilt Transmission		
11	Installation and Repair Services; and,

13	from qualified vendors for the transmission installation and repair; and,		
14	WHEREAS, after a competitive bidding process, it was determined that United Engines the only		
15	bidder for the Annual Contract with a one (1)-year contract term and two (2), one (1)-year renewals for an		
16	annual amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) was qualified to		
17	perform the work.		
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
19	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
20	Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an annual one (1)-year contract with not more		
21	than two (2), one (1)-year renewal extensions with United Engines for an annual budget amount not to		
22	exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00).		
23	Section 2. Funds for this purchase are to be allocated in the Fleet Services Parts Account No. 600013-		
24	60310.		
25	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or		
26	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
27	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and		
28	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the		
29	resolution.		
30	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with		
31	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
