The outdoor pool is heavily patronized by individuals from all ethnic and socio-economic backgrounds.</p> <p>The current filtration system is at least twenty-five (25) years old and now needs to be replaced by a new and more efficient system.</p>

**BACKGROUND  
CONTINUED**

In order to obtain the best system, staff has consulted with both the Arkansas State Health Department and other pool experts. As such, Bid # 15117 was advertised and three (3) bid were received. Of the three (3) bid received, Blue Water Pools submitted the low bid of \$70,960.00. Staff recommends that the bid be awarded to Blue Water Pools in the amount of \$70,960.00.
