BACKGROUND	<p>On December 20, 2022, the City of Little Rock Board of Directors approved Resolution No. 15,847, to state the intended uses of the remaining portion of the second tranche to the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, allotment of the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, through the American Rescue Plan Act.</p> <p>Due to the projection of costs for the new West Little Rock Fire Station rising above the originally allocated funds, Resolution 15,487 needs to be revised to strike “and an updated apparatus bay at Station No. 16” on line 2; page 2.</p>
