SYNOPSIS	In an effort by the Land Bank to maximize the City's revitalization efforts, staff would like to transfer the properties located at 2613 Abigail Street, 4021 West 23 rd Street, 4624 West 23 rd Street, 4301 West 25 th Street and 5118 West 31 st Street, Little Rock, Arkansas, to the University District Development Corporation. The vacant lots range in size from 2,500 square-feet to 7,000 square-feet.

BACKGROUND CONTINUED
