SYNOPSIS FISCAL IMPACT	This ordinance waives competitive bidding for the purchase of up to twelve (12) months of Software Maintenance and Support for the NGIT Altaris application for the City's Computer-Aided 911 Dispatch System. The total cost for this 12 months of extended service is \$192,207 plus tax. The City will have an option to terminate the maintenance service upon thirty (30)-day notice. The maintenance will be paid for from the Information Technology Department's Annual Operating
