	Officials in appropriate cases that address issues of illegal immigration; and,
	WHEREAS, it is important for the City to declare its intentions always to comply with State and
	Federal Statutory and Constitutional Requirements.
	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
	Section 1. The City will not engage in any program or activity which would require a failure to
	cooperate to the extent provided by law with any appropriate Federal Agency that needs to obtain
	information about citizenship or immigration status of a person in the custody of the City.
	Section 2. The City will not engage in any program or activity which violates an individual's statutory
	or constitutional rights in order to cooperate with any appropriate Federal Agency that needs to obtain
	information about citizenship or immigration status of a person in the custody of the City.
	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
	word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and
	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
	ordinance.
	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
	the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
