4	AND TO ESTABLISH A PLANNED DEVELOPMENT – COMMERCIAL
5	TITLED MASTER COMPANY PD-C, LOCATED AT 9911 WEST
6	MARKHAM STREET (Z-9858), LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS, AMENDING
7	THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK,
8	ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
9	THE STATE OF STILLE OF SELECTION OF SELECTIO
10	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK,
11	ARKANSAS.
12	Section 1. That the zoning classification of the following described property be changed from O-3,
13	General Office District, to PD-C, Planned Development – Commercial:
14	<b>Z-9858</b> : Described as a part of Lot 8, West Markham Street Subdivision, Little Rock,
15	Pulaski County, Arkansas, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the north
16	line of said Lot 8, which is 100 feet east of the northwest corner of said Lot 8; thence
17	east along said north line of 91.5 feet to the west right-of-way line of Oak Lane Drive;
18	thence south along the west right-of-way line of Oak Lane Drive, 105 feet; thence west
19	91.5 feet; thence north 105 feet to the point of beginning. Less and except that part
20	taken by Arkansas State Highway Commission, Parcel No. 44L0470005100.
21	Section 2. That the preliminary site development plan/plat be approved as presented to the Little Rock
22	Planning Commission.
23	Section 3. That the change in zoning classification contemplated for Master Company PD-C, located
24	at 9911 West Markham (Z-9858), is conditioned upon obtaining final plan approval within the time
25	specified by Chapter 36, Article VII, Section 36-454 (e) of the Code of Ordinances.
26	<b>Section 4.</b> That this ordinance shall not take effect and be in full force until the final plan approval.
27	Section 5. That the map referred to in Chapter 36 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Little Rock,
28	Arkansas, and the Designated District Map be, and is hereby amended, to the extent and in the respects
29	necessary to affect and designate the change provided for in Section 1 hereof.
30	Section 6. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
31	word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
32	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance, which shall remain in full force and
33	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
34	ordinance.
