3	A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE PARTICIPATION IN THE
4	ARKANSAS MUNICIPAL LEAGUE VEHICLE PROGRAM, IN AN
5	AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND
6	DOLLARS (\$450,000.00), TO COVER ADDITIONAL VEHICLES ADDED
7	TO THE CITY'S VEHICLE INVENTORY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

9	WHEREAS, an Arkansas municipality is required to have available the minimum amount of funds to
10	provide coverage for damages in motor vehicle accidents for the various motor vehicles that it owns or
11	uses; and,
12	WHEREAS, the most efficient way to provide this coverage is to participate in the Arkansas Municipal
13	League Vehicle Program for both the payment and administration of any appropriate claims; and,
14	WHEREAS, pursuant to Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 14,449 (November 15, 2016), the Board of
15	Directors authorized participation in this program; however, since that time additional vehicles have been
16	added to the City's inventory;
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
18	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
19	Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary papers for the City of Little Rock
20	to participate in the Arkansas Municipal League Vehicle Program for an amount not to exceed Four
21	Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) to cover additional vehicles added to the City's inventory
22	in 2017.
23	Section 2. Funds for this payment are available in Fleet Services Operating Account No. 600020-
24	63610.
25	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
26	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
27	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
28	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
29	resolution.
30	Section 4. Repealer. All resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this resolution are
31	hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency including, but not limited to, Little Rock, Ark.,
32	Resolution No. 14,449 (November 15, 2016).
