SYNOPSIS  FISCAL IMPACT	Authorizes the City Manager to enter into contract for Housing Opportunities for Persons With AIDS (HOPWA) Grant Funding to the Arkansas Regional Commission in a total amount not to exceed \$90,000 for one (1)-year. The City will have the option to renew the term two (2) times in one (1)-year increments with the right to terminate the agreement upon completion of the Federally-Funded Housing Programs.  The City receives an annual allocation of HOPWA Funds from the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD). The contract is consistent with the City's adopted Citizen Participation Plan and the

RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	The City of Little Rock is designated by HUD as an entitlement jurisdiction to administer the HOPWA Program for a six (6) county area including Pulaski, Faulkner, Saline, Lonoke, Perry, and Grant Counties. The City issued a 2 <sup>nd</sup> Request for Qualifications dated January 8, 2019, to procure a service provider for HOPWA assistance.	

## BACKGROUND CONTINUED

On February 12, 2019, the Arkansas Regional Commission was selected by the Selection Committee to provide HOPWA services over one (1)-year, with the City's option to renew the term two (2) times in one (1)-year increments for Faulkner County. Arkansas Regional Commission (\$90,000) will provide Tenant-Based Rental Assistance, Short-Term Rent, Mortgage, and Utilities Assistance, Permanent Housing Placement Services, and Supportive Services in Faulkner County.
