<p>SYNOPSIS</p> <p>FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p>RECOMMENDATION</p> <p>CITIZEN PARTICIPATION</p> <p>BACKGROUND</p>	<p>To amend the Interlocal Agreement forming PAgis (Pulaski Area Geographic Information System) to add the City of Sherwood, Arkansas, to the agreement.</p> <p>None.</p> <p>Staff recommends approval.</p> <p>N/A</p> <p>PAgis (Pulaski Area Geographic Information System) is a consortium of the City of Little Rock, Central Arkansas Water, Little Rock Wastewater Utility, City of North Little Rock, North Little Rock Wastewater Utility, City of Jacksonville, and Pulaski County (Public Works). PAgis provides mapping and GIS data to its member agencies (updating basemaps/data, training, and as a data clearing house). The consortium has continued discussions with other public agencies within Pulaski County regarding membership to share resources. The City of Sherwood now wishes joins this consortium providing some of their resources with PAgis assisting them with some general mapping and GIS issues. To this end the inter-local agreement is being amended to add the City of Sherwood.</p>
