9	WHEREAS, the City of Little Rock, Arkansas ("the City"), undertook the preservation of historic
10	Curran Hall, and after substantial work and agreements elected to operate it as a Tourist Information
11	Center for the City; and,
12	WHEREAS, pursuant to Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 12,419 (January 16, 2007), the City Board
13	of Directors authorized an Agreement between the City and the Quapaw Quarter Association for the
14	operation of a Tourist Information Center, and Resolution No. 13,118 (April 20, 2010) modified and
15	extended the lease terms for an additional three (3) years; and,
16	WHEREAS, the three (3)-year term of that agreement has now expired but the City has continued to
17	operate pursuant to the terms of that agreement, and to formally ratify the actions taken by both parties
18	pursuant to that agreement; and,
19	WHEREAS, with minor changes the City wishes to enter into another agreement with the Quapaw
20	Quarter Association for operation of Curran Hall;
21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
22	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
23	Section 1. Section 1(e) of Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 13,118 (April 20, 2010), is hereby
24	amended to read as follows:
25	(e) The term of this Agreement may be extended in two (2), one (1)-year increments,
26	provided no extension will occur if any party provides forty-five (45) days written
27	notice to the other parties that the agreement will terminate on December 31st of the
28	current operating year, provided that this Agreement shall not extend past December
29	31, 2019.
