SYNOPSIS	An ordinance to amend Resolution No 15,015 (June 18, 2019) and to increase the contract amount with Ben Nelsen Golf and Utility Vehicles, for the lease of an additional fifteen (15) Golf Carts per month at Rebsamen Golf Course.	
FISCAL IMPACT	The total contract to be amended in the amount of \$29,000 for a total of \$171,282.40, and funding will come from Golf General Fund Operating Budget	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the ordinance.	
BACKGROUND	In 1998, the Golf Liaison Committee concurred with Parks & Recreation Staff that Golf Carts should be leased. Due to the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic, and resulting operating changes to ensure customer safety, Rebsamen Golf Course currently only allows one (1) rider per cart. As a result, available carts have been rented early in the day and has led to customer's not having a cart to rent and a resulting loss in potential revenue.	

BACKGROUND CONTINUED

The addition of fifteen (15) carts will ensure that carts will be available for rental to those that wish to do so, and will also result in an increase in revenue generated. Pending the status of the pandemic, if two (2) riders per cart is allowed, staff will discontinue the rental of the additional fifteen (15) carts.
