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12	WHEREAS, the Information Technology Department has a need to enter into a contract with Dell		
13	Services for the purchase, installation and configuration of additional storage capacity for the City of		
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15	WHEREAS, the cost of the additional storage capacity contract term will co-term with the current		
16	Dell Maintenance Contract scheduled and will expire in April 2024; and,		
17	WHEREAS, vendor section was made through the Arkansas State Contract No. C000000012102

19	WHEREAS, the contract provides for the purchase, installation and configuration of equipment to		
20	provide additional storage capacity for the City's Active-Active Data Centers at a total contract cost not to		
21	exceed Three Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand, Five Hundred Fifty-Eight and 42/100 Dollars		
22	(\$376,558.42), plus applicable shipping, taxes and fees.		
23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
24	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
25	Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with		
26	Dell Services for a contract term to co-term with the existing Dell Maintenance Contract and will expire		
27	in April 2024.		
28	Section 2. Funding for the total contract amount of Three Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand, Five		
29	Hundred Fifty-Eight and 42/100 Dollars (\$376,558.42), plus applicable shipping, taxes and fees, will		
30	come from the 3/8-Capital Improvement Sales Tax and Special Projects Accounts.		
31	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or		
32	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
33	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and		
34	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
