<p style="text-align: center;"><b>SYNOPSIS</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>FISCAL IMPACT</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>RECOMMENDATION</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>BACKGROUND</b></p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with Noland Construction, Inc., for the Oakland &amp; Fraternal Cemetery Street and Drainage Improvements Project, Bid No. 828.</p> <p>Amount for Construction Services is not to exceed \$274,281.60, which is the base bid amount of \$228,568.00, plus 20% contingencies. Funding for this project is from the allocation for City-Wide Projects of the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds and the 2018 Capital Improvement Bonds.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>This project provides new curb and gutter along the main entrance from Barber Street and new storm sewers to replace old collapsed sewers to address roadway and drainage problems in the historic cemetery. Noland Construction, Inc., was the lowest, responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications of eight (8) bids received for the project.</p>
