16	WHEREAS, NEOGOV is the sole supplier for the Human Resource Software Licenses and related		
17	services for Insight Enterprise; NEOGOV Onboard; and NEOGOV Core HR Employee Management; and		
18	WHEREAS, Little Rock, Ark. Ordinance No. 21,821 (December 17, 2019) approved the Human		
19	Resources Division NEOGOV Software Services upgrade to include the NEOGOV Onboard Program in		
20	an amount not to exceed Seventy Thousand, Seven Hundred Forty-Five and 73/100 Dollars (\$70,745.73),		
21	plus applicable taxes and fees; and,		
22	WHEREAS, the Human Resources Division requests an amendment to Ordinance No.21,821 for the		
23	purchase of the LEARN Module and job posting expansion to Governmentjobs.com and to increase the
