11	WHEREAC and described of the Communication Contact and advantage of the Communication Contact and advantage of the Communication Contact and the Contact		
12 13	WHEREAS, periodic review of the Communication Center's organizational structure, programs and		
13	procedures is essential to efficient, professional operation of the Center as new technology develops and as		
15	public needs change; and,  WHEREAS, an independent audit of the Little Rock Emergency Communications Center's operations		
16	performed by a public safety communications expert would help to identify equipment, staffing and training		
17	needs and to pinpoint any performance issues that need to be addressed; and,		
18	WHEREAS, the emergency dispatch operational standards adopted by the City were developed by the		
19	Association of Public-Safety Communications Officials, International (APCO), a public safety		
20	communications standards developer accredited by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI); and,		
21	WHEREAS, it would be impracticable and contrary to the public interest to hire any consultant other		
22			
23	met at the Little Rock Communications Center and, in light of that evaluation, to provide communications		
24	managers with advice on any issues surrounding effective and efficient operations; and,		
25	WHEREAS, the Little Rock Board of Directors feels that this is a unique situation which makes		
26	competitive bidding impracticable and contrary to the best interest of the City.		
27	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
28	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
29	Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Association of		
30	Public-Safety Communications Officials, International for a communications audit and associated		
31	consulting services in the amount of Twenty-Two Thousand, One Hundred Dollars (\$22,100.00) plus		
32	applicable taxes.		

1	Section 2. Because of the critical need t	o utilize the City's current public safety communications	
2	standards as efficiently and effectively as possible by requesting that the developer of those standard		
3	identify any procedural or technical shortfalls, the Board declares that it is impractical and unfeasible t		
4	submit this matter to a competitive bid process, and, therefore, waives competitive bidding.		
5	Section 3. Funds for this service are available in the Little Rock Police Department's Seized Asse		
6	Forfeiture Funds.		
7	Section 4. Severability. In the event any portion of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid		
8	or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this		
9	ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid of		
10	unconstitutional were not originally a part of this ordinance.		
11	Section 5. Repealer. All ordinances and resolutions, and parts thereof, which are in conflict with any		
12	provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.		
13	Section 6. Emergency Clause. It is essential to the public health, safety, and welfare to determine		
14	whether the APCO operational and training standards are met by the Little Rock Communications Center		
15	and to address any issues that are identified with respect to effective and efficient operation of the Center		
16	an emergency is, therefore, declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and		
17	after the date of its passage.
