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| WHEREAS, the Arkansas Department of Transportation (ArDOT) has reviewed ownership of the |
| right-of-way for the widening and reconstruction of Interstate 30 and Interstate 40 from Interstate 530 to |
| Highway 67 and determined that the City of Little Rock owns the right-of-way of Tracts 20, 20E-1, 20E- |
| 2, 22, 26, 26E-1, 26E-2, 26E-3, 29E-1 as identified in Job No. CA0602; and, |
| WHEREAS, it is desirable that the City of Little Rock would transfer the ownership of this right-of- |
| way property to ArDOT for this important transportation improvement project. |
| NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY |
| OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS: |
| Section 1. The Mayor, City Manager and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute, in a form |
| approved by the City Attorney, any sales contracts and documents required to donate and convey to |
| ArDOT, the public right-of-way and land located in Pulaski County, Arkansas, described as Tracts 20, |
| 20E1, 20E2, 22, 26, 26E-1, 26E-2, 26E-3, 29E-1 on the right-of-way maps of ArDOT Job No. CA0602. |
| Section 2. Upon passing and receipt of this resolution, the Arkansas State Highway Commission will |
| commence the transfer process of the right-of-way from the City of Little Rock. |
| Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or |
| word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or |
| adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and |
| effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the |
| resolution. |
| Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent |
| with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. |
