18	point of beginning, being Being Tract 21 of Subdivision of E1/4 SE1/4 NW1/4; SW1/4 NE1/4		
19	and NW1/4 SE1/4 of Section 24 Township 2 North Range 14 West, according to the survey		
20	of G. A. Denham, Registered Engineer, containing 4.93 acres, more or less.
