<p>SYNOPSIS</p> <p>FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p>RECOMMENDATION</p> <p>BACKGROUND</p>	<p>Authorizes the award of a Contract with Jacobs Engineering Group for Professional Engineering Consultant Services for the design of River Trail Federal Land Access Project Grant improvements.</p> <p>Funding for the project will be in the amount of \$77,415.00, and will be part of the required grant match from Street Fund Special Projects, Activity No. S40G621.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>The City has received a Federal Land Access Project (FLAP) Grant to construct trail improvements that will complete the River Trail connection to the new pedestrian bridge east of the Union Pacific Railroad mainline and provide for a connection to the future Southwest Trail. The grant provides for 80% of construction cost with the City match consisting of 20% of construction plus the design cost. Jacobs Engineering Group was selected through a Statement of Qualifications process to provide trail design work for this project. This project consists of two (2) parts: Terracon Consultants, Inc., is providing design services for stabilization of the Arkansas River bank and Jacobs Engineering Group is proposed to provide design of the trail and retaining walls.</p>
