13	WHEREAS, the Fleet Services Department is in need of two (2) E-One Custom Pumpers on Cyclone		
14	II Chassis for the Little Rock Fire Department; and,		
15	WHEREAS, by utilizing the Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAG), the City Fleet Services can		
16	purchase the E-One Cyclone Custom Pumpers from Sunbelt Fire for the amount of One Million, One		
17	Hundred Forty-Five Thousand, Four Hundred and Twenty-One Dollars (\$1,145,421.00).		
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
19	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
20	Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with		
21	Sunbelt Fire for the purchase of two (2) E-One Custom Pumpers on Cyclone II Chassis, utilizing the		
22	Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) Cooperative Purchasing Agreement, for the amount of One		
23	Million, One Hundred Forty-Five Thousand, Four Hundred and Twenty-One Dollars (\$1,145,421.00)		
24	Section 2. Funds for this purchase are allocated in the 5/8-Cent Sales Tax Account.		
25	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or		
26	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
27	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and		
28	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the		
29	resolution .		
30	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with		
31	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
