6	(\$230,000.00), TO PROVIDE TECHNICAL CONSULTING SERVICES
7	FOR THE 2017 GIS STORM WATER SYSTEM MAPPING AND DATA
8	COLLECTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

10	WHEREAS, the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, has been awarded a grant from the Pulaski Area
11	Geographic Information System (PAGIS) for Storm Water Map Data Development, authorized by
12	Resolution No. 14,509, and
13	WHEREAS, FTN Associates, Ltd., was selected by committee through a professional annua
14	Request for Statements of Qualifications Process, Bid No. 17104, as the most qualified firm to provide
15	services.
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
17	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
18	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the FTN Associates
19	Ltd., in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$230,000.00) including
20	contingencies.
21	Section 2. Funding for this contract is from a grant from the Pulaski Area Geographical System in
22	the amount of One Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$185,000.00) and Street Fund Specia
23	Projects in an amount not to exceed Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$45.000.00).
24	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, o
25	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration of
26	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
27	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
28	resolution.
29	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
30	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
31	Section 5. This resolution will be in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.
