| SYNOPSIS   | The applicant is requesting approval of PD-O, Planned Development — Office, zoning to allow for the development of the site with a 3,070 square-foot, one (1)-story Credit Union Branch Building. The proposal includes a fifteen (15)-space parking lot, and right-in and right-out driveways are to be constructed off of both University Avenue and Evergreen Drive. Covered drivethru services and ATM lanes will be located on the south side of the new building. |                                |
| FISCAL IMPACT  | None.   |                                |
| RECOMMENDATION   | Staff recommends approval of the PD-O zoning. The Planning Commission voted 9 ayes, 0 nays and 2 absent to recommend approval.  |                                |
| BACKGROUND   | Staff is supportive of the proposed PD-O, Planned Development – Office, for a Credit Union Building. Although the plan does not comply fully with all aspects of the Midtown Design Overlay District (DOD), staff feels the applicant has proposed a quality development. The property is located at the northern edge of the DOD and is not within what was anticipated to be the more pedestrian-oriented area of the Midtown DOD.                                    |                                |
