| 17 | Rock Planning Commission.   |  |
| 18 | Section 3. That the change in zoning classification contemplated for 517 Maple Street Short-Form                |  |
| 19 | PD-R, located at 517 Maple Street (Z-9404) is conditioned upon obtaining final plan approval within the         |  |
| 20 | time specified by Chapter 36, Article VII, Section 36-454 (e) of the Code of Ordinances.                        |  |
| 21 | <b>Section 4.</b> That this ordinance shall not take effect and be in full force until the final plan approval. |  |
| 22 | Section 5. That the map referred to in Chapter 36 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Little Rock,         |  |
| 23 | Arkansas, and Designated District Map be and is hereby amended to the extent and in the respects necessary      |  |
| 24 | to affect and designate the change provided for in Section 1 hereof.  |  |

| 28 | effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the   |  |
