10	WHEREAS, the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, receives an annual allocation of Housing Opportunity	
11	for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) Funds from the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Developmen	
12	(HUD); and,	
13	WHEREAS, the City of Little Rock is designated by HUD as an entitlement jurisdiction to	
14	administer the HOPWA Program for a six (6)-County area including: Pulaski; Faulkner; Saline; Lonoke;	
15	Perry; and Grant Counties; and,	
16	WHEREAS, funding through the HOPWA Program was designated for housing assistance and	
17	appropriate supportive services for low-income persons HIV positive; and,	
18	WHEREAS, on March 11, 2019, the City issued a Request for Qualifications to procure a service	
19	provider of the HOPWA assistance; and,	
20	WHEREAS, on April 9, 2019, Pulaski County Community Services was selected by the Selection	
21	Committee to provide HOPWAS services for a period of one (1)-year, with the City's option to renew the	
22	term two (2) times in one (1)-year increments for Pulaski County; and,	
23	WHEREAS, Pulaski County Community Services will provide Tenant-Based Rental Assistance;	
24	Short-Term Rent, Mortgage, and Utility Assistance; Permanent Housing Placement Services; and	
25	Supportive Services in Pulaski County in the amount of Three Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand, Three	
26	Hundred Forty-Six and 80/100 Dollars (\$382,346.80); and,	
27	WHEREAS, pursuant to this approval, the City entered into a contract with the Pulaski County	
28	Community Services to provide HOPWA services for a one (1)-year term, with the City's option to renew	
29 20	the term of the contracts for two (2) additional one (1)-year terms; and, WHEPEAS the contract is consistent with the City's educted Citizen Participation Plan and the	
30	WHEREAS, the contract is consistent with the City's adopted Citizen Participation Plan and the	
31 32	Consolidated Planning Committee and the recommended sources and uses of the City's 2018-2019 HUD Entitlement Funds.

1	Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby approves funding to the Pulaski County Community		
2	Services in the amount of Three Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand, Three Hundred Forty-Six and 80/100		
3	Dollars (\$382,346.86) for one (1)-year term, with the City's option to renew the term two (2) times in one		
4	(1)-year increments.		
5	Section 2. The recommended sources for funding and uses are from the City's 2018-2019 HUD		
6	Entitlement Funds.		
7	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or		
8	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
9	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and		
10	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the		
11	resolution.		
12	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent		
13	with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
