

1 **Section 1.** The City Manager is authorized to enter into a two (2)-year contract with ShotSpotter, Inc.,
2 d/b/a SST, Inc. for the purchase of a wide-area gunshot detection service in the amount not to exceed Two
3 Hundred Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$290,000.00).

4 **Section 2.** Funding for this expenditure is available through a Department of Justice FY 17
5 Technology Innovation for Public Safety (TIPS) Grant in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand
6 Dollars (\$250,000.00), Account No. 270529-G35158, and the remaining Forty Thousand Dollars
7 (\$40,000.00) balance will be paid from the Federal Equitable Sharing Seized Funds, Account No. 270529-
8 G35148;

9 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
10 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
11 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
12 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
13 resolution.

14 **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
15 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
