SYNOPSIS FISCAL IMPACT	A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a Construction Contract with Carson & Associates, Inc., for the rehabilitation of the Jericho Way Day Resource Center, located at 3000 Springer Boulevard. The total cost is not to exceed \$401,850.00, which includes a 20% contingency. The renovation will use DHS-ESG MATCH Funding, Funding Source - ESG Match-COVID.	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	The City of Little Rock received an allocation of Emergency Services Grant (ESG) Match Investment Partnerships Program (CDBG-CV) Funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to acquire, develop and/or rehabilitate housing for low to moderate-income persons.	
	In an effort improve the structure conditions for Jericho Way Day Resource Center and the homeless population, the kitchen & dining hall need to be rehabilitated to assist those residents confronting homelessness. This project will improve the health and well-being of patrons. The City has worked in partnership with this organization for ten (10) years.	

BACKGROUND CONTINUED

The structure is located at 3000 Springer Boulevard and is on a 12,327 +/- square-foot (.28 total acres) lot. The structure was built in 1955.

Bid No. 2114 was issued to obtain competitive, qualified bids to rehabilitate the property and Carson & Associates, Inc., provided the only responsive, responsible bid that met specifications.
