9	Sixty Thousand, Four Hundred-One Dollars (\$460,401.00), plus 20% contingencies.
0	SECTION 2. Funding for this project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating
1	Use Tax Funds and the 2013 Capital Improvements Bonds for Streets and Drainage as authorized by Resolution
2	No. 13,699 and amended by Resolution No. 14,269.
3	<b>SECTION 3.</b> <i>Severability</i> . In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word
4	of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall
5	not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so
6	declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the resolution.
7	SECTION 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
28	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
