<p><b>SYNOPSIS</b></p> <p><b>FISCAL IMPACT</b></p> <p><b>RECOMMENDATION</b></p> <p><b>BACKGROUND</b></p>	<p>The incumbent provider of Workers' Compensation Stop-Loss Coverage (Safety National) has offered a renewal effective July 1, 2016. They are proposing a \$220,535 deposit premium, to be audited at year-end. There is a question as to whether this contract is subject to rebid; however, the coverage technically expired on June 30, 2016. This contract allows an extension for a one (1)-year period while the question on the need to rebid the contract is concluded.</p> <p>Amounts required for this coverage were budgeted in the 2016 budget line item for Workers' Compensation Program</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>Approval of a sole-source ordinance to authorize the City Manager to extend the existing policy with Safety National, as a temporary sole-source, to continue the Stop-Loss Workers' Compensation Coverage.</p>
