SYNOPSIS	To authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with Garrett Excavating, Inc., formerly InTrench USA, for the Oakland & Fraternal Cemetery Street and Drainage Improvement Project, Bid No. 828.	
FISCAL IMPACT	The amount for Construction Services is not to exceed \$279,475.92, which is the base bid amount of \$232,896.60, plus 20% contingencies. Funding for this project is from the allocation for city-wide projects of the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds and the Limited Tax General Obligation Capital Improvement Bonds.	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	This project provides new curb and gutter along the main entrance from Barber Street and new storm sewers to replace old collapsed sewers to address roadway and drainage problems in the historic cemetery. Garrett Excavating, Inc., formerly InTrench USA, was the second lowest, responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications of eight (8) bids received for the project. This contract will replace the contract previously awarded to Noland Construction, the original low bidder.
