SYNOPSIS	A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with Crafton, Tull & Associates, Inc., for Professional Engineering Consultant Services for the Fourche Dam Pike at Interstate 440 Traffic Signal Improvements.	
FISCAL IMPACT	Amount for Engineering Services is not to exceed \$72,000.00. Funding for this project is from the Arkansas Economic Development Agency with local match funds from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds and the Capital Improvement Bonds.

BACKGROUND	The project includes improvements to the Fourche Dam Pike at Interstate 440 interchange, north of the railroad tracks, as well as railroad crossing and signal improvements.
