SYNOPSIS	A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with D&J Red Iron and Aggregates, Ltd., for the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Drive Drainage Improvements, Project No. 1-17-DR-53, Bid No. 899.	
FISCAL IMPACT	Amount for Construction Services is not to exceed \$448,069.37, which is the base bid amount of \$373,391.14, plus 20% contingencies. Funding for this project is from the <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> -Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds and the Capital Improvement Bonds as authorized by Resolution No. 14,803.	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	This project provides storm sewer culvert replacement improvements for the creek crossing at Longlea Drive, south of El Dorado Drive. Redstone Construction Group was the lowest, responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications of seven (7) bids received for the project.
