SYNOPSIS	The applicant is requesting that the property located at 321 Rice Street be rezoned from R-3, Single-Family District, and I-2, Light Industrial District, to PRD, Planned Residential District, to allow for the construction of two (2) single-family residences.

RECOMMENDATION	Staff recommends approval of the PRD zoning. The Planning Commission voted to recommend approval by a vote of 10 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent.	
BACKGROUND	The applicant is proposing to construct two (2) single-family residences on this property. The property would be replatted to create two (2) lots of the same width. This project contains 0.22 acres and is located at 321 Rice Street. Most of the parcel is zoned R-3, Single-Family District, and a small portion is zoned I-2, Light Industrial District.

BACKGROUND Each residence is proposed to be two (2)-stories and to contain 1,485 square-feet of living area. The proposed homes would be set back twenty-five (25) feet from the right-of-way of Rice Street. The side-yard setbacks are shown as 7.5 feet, and the rear setback would be the standard single-family residential measurement of twenty-five (25) feet. Access from Rice Street would be via a concrete driveway situated generally at the northwest corner of the home. The Planning Commission reviewed this request at their May
