SYNOPSIS	Authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with Redstone Construction Group, Inc., for the construction of Main Street Water Quality Improvement Project for Main Street, Phase II in the 600 and 700 blocks, Bid No. 17010. <i>This project is in Ward 1</i> .	
FISCAL IMPACT	Funding for this project is from an Environmental Protection Agency - Arkansas Natural Resource Conservation Grant Low Impact Development (LID) Grant for \$536,500.00 and from Turnback Funds. The amount for construction services is not to exceed \$1,268,586.30, which is the negotiated base bid amount of \$1,057,155.25, plus 20% contingencies.	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	This project is a continuation of a previous Water Quality Demonstration Project utilizing sustainable low impact development concepts for Non-Source Point Storm Water Management and Streetscapes in the 600 and 700 block of Main Street. The project will include rain gardens, porous pavement and other sustainable development infrastructure to capture, detain and improve water quality. Redstone Construction Group was the lowest responsive, responsible bid of two (2) received for the project.
