SYNOPSIS FISCAL IMPACT	 Authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with the Little Rock Wastewater Utility for rehabilitation of the City-owned Jim Dailey Fitness & Aquatic Center sewerage outfall. <i>This project is in Ward 3</i>. Funding for this project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax, War Memorial and Park Capital Upgrade Fund. Amount for construction services is \$102,030.84, which is \$85,025.70, plus 20% contingencies. 	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	This project provides for rehabilitation of the city-owned sewer outfall from the Jim Dailey Fitness & Aquatic Center. The old sewer line, which has partially collapsed, is filled with roots and obstructions and is in need of replacement or full rehabilitation. The Little Rock Wastewater Utility has agreed to perform this work under their open contract for sewer rehabilitation services and the City will reimburse the actual final cost for services. This rehabilitation work is in the same area as the Zoo Drive Roundabout and will be performed during the
