BACKGROUND	The Little Rock Police Department (LRPD) is required to hold a public hearing in order that the Police Department may advise the public regarding proposed expenditures. The allocation amount for Pulaski County has been established at \$38,905.00, and as part of the application process, LRPD, as the fiscal agency for this grant, is required to notify its Governing Body of this eligibility.

## BACKGROUND CONTINUED

LRPD is required to hold a public hearing in order that they may advise the public regarding proposed expenditures. The Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance (JAG) Grant Program is the leading source of Federal Justice Funding to State and Local Jurisdictions. The JAG Program provides States, Tribes and Local Governments with critical funding necessary to support a range of program areas including law enforcement, prosecution, indigent defense, courts, crime prevention and education, corrections and community corrections, drug treatment and enforcement, planning, evaluation, technology improvement, and crime victim and witness initiatives and Mental Health Programs and related Law Enforcement and Corrections Programs, including Behavioral Programs and Crisis Intervention Teams.
