25	2017001134.	
26	Section 2. Total cost of this purchase is Sixty-One Thousand, Five Hundred Twenty-Eight and 78/100	
27	Dollars (\$61,528.78), plus applicable taxes and fee, and funds for this purchase are allocated in the Zoo	
28	Upgrades Account 326659-TS65A32.	
29	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of	
30	this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication	
31	shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the	
32	portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the resolution.
