12	WHEREAS, the Finance Department Purchasing Division and the Planning & Development	
13	Department ("Purchasing and Planning") requests software upgrades to allow for additional configuration,	
14	functionality, and to streamline the Enterprise Resource Planning Software and other Planning Systems;	
15	and,	
16	WHEREAS, pursuant to the Request for Qualifications No. 707, Purchasing and Planning sought the	
17	services of a qualified consultant to upgrade software and other planning systems and through this process	
18	determined TruePoint Solutions were the most qualified firm to perform this work; and,	
19	WHEREAS, the total cost for the contract is not to exceed Eight Hundred Twenty-One Thousand	
20	Dollars (\$821,000.00), plus applicable taxes and fees, with funding provided by the American Rescue Plan	
21	Act.	
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY	
23	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:	
24	Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with TruePoint Solutions for	
25	Software and Information Technology Upgrades for the Finance Department Purchasing Division and the	
26	Planning & Development Department in the amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Twenty-One Thousand	
27	Dollars (\$821,000.00), plus applicable taxes and fees.	
28	Section 2. Funds for this expenditure will be taken from Account No. 271 – American Rescue Plan.	
29	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or	
30	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or	
31	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and	
32	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the	
33	resolution.
