13	SECTION 1. That the zoning classification of the following described property be changed from R-
14	2, Single-Family, to PCD, Planned Commercial Development:
15	Z-6238-A: PARCEL A - BEING A PART OF THE N1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF THE
16	NW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 9, T-1-N, R-13-W, IN PULASKI COUNTY,
17	ARKANSAS, AND ALSO BEING THE JIM AND KAYE WOOD TRACT
18	RECORDED AS DOCUMENT 96-32975 IN THE PULASKI COUNTY ARKANSAS
19	CIRCUIT CLERK'S OFFICE. MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS
20	FOLLOWS, WITH ALL BEARING REFERENCED TO THE NORTH LINE OF
21	THE SAID JIM AND KAYE WOOD TRACT AS RECORDED IN SAID

19	DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: BEGINNING AT AN IRON PIN TWENTY-FIVE		
20	(25) FEET WEST AND 105 FEET SOUTH OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF		
21	SAID N1/2 SE1/4 NW1/4 NW1/4; RUN THENCE SOUTH SIXTY (60) FEET TO AN		
22	IRON PIN; RUN THENCE WEST 200 FEET TO AN IRON PIN; RUN THENCE		
23	NORTH SIXTY (60) FEET TO AN IRON PIN; RUN THENCE EAST 200 FEET TO		
24	AN IRON PIN AND THE POINT OF BEGINNING.		
25	SECTION 2. That the preliminary site development plan/plat be approved as recommended by the		
26	Little Rock Planning Commission.		
27	SECTION 3. That the change in zoning classification contemplated for Bowman Road Retail		
28	Development Short-Form PCD (Z-6238-A), located at 1400 and 1404 South Bowman Road, is conditioned		
29	upon obtaining final plan approval within the time specified by Chapter 36, Article VII, Section 36-454 (e)		
30	of the Code of Ordinances.		
31	SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall not take effect and be in full force until the final plan approval.		
32	SECTION 5. That the map referred to in Chapter 36 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Little		
33	Rock, Arkansas, and designated district map be and is hereby amended to the extent and in the respects		

34 necessary to affect and designate the change provided for in Section 1 hereof.

1	SECTION 6. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase,		
2	or word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
3	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and		
4	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the		
5	ordinance.		
6	SECTION 7. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent		
7	with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
