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11	WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was issued for an annual purchasing contract to provide the			
12	purchase of batteries for use in all City of Little Rock Fleet units; and,			
13	WHEREAS, Summit Truck Group was the lowest qualified bidder of three (3) total bids received			
14	through the formal bidding process; and,			
15	WHEREAS, the total amount for the annual purchasing contract for batteries will be Sixty Thousand			
16	Dollars (\$60,000.00) annually;			
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY			
18	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:			
19	Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into an annual			
20	purchase contract with Mid-South Sales for the purchase of batteries for use in all City of Little Rock			
21	Fleet units, in an amount of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) annually.			
22	Section 2. This Annual Purchase Order will be for one (1)-year, with an option to renew each year up			
23	to two (2) additional years.			
24	Section 3. Funds for this purchase are allocated in Fleet Services 2015 Budgeted Parts Account.			
25	Section 4. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or			
26	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or			
27	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and			
28	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the			
29	resolution.			
30	Section 5. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent			
31	with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
