12	WHEREAS, it is desirable to provide engineering study and design work for new sidewalks on			
13	Markham Street from Kavanaugh Boulevard to Pine Street, where sidewalks are either inadequate or not			
14	provided to provide for pedestrian needs in the area; and,			
15	WHEREAS, McClelland Consulting Engineers, Inc., was selected through a Statement of			
16	Qualifications process, Bid No. 18179, to provide Engineering Design and Survey Services for the proposed			
17	project in Ward 3.

20	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with McClelland			
21	Consulting Engineers, Inc., to provide Engineering Design and Survey Services for the Markham Street			
22	Sidewalks, from Kavanaugh Boulevard to Pine Street, in amount not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-Two			
23	Thousand, Five Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$122,500.00).			
24	Section 2. Funding for this contract is will be from a Street Fund Special Project.			
25	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or			
26	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or			
27	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and			
28	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the			
29	resolution.			
30	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with			
31	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
