Moore City Manager Department **SYNOPSIS** A resolution to authorize the City Manager to apply for a Surface Transportation Program Grant from Metroplan for trail development for the Tri-Creek Greenway Project. FISCAL IMPACT Anticipated Federal Funding in the amount of \$500,000.00 will be requested. The grant will require matching funds in the amount of 20% (\$100,000.00), which will be from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales Tax Funds, Account No. 326459 TS45A21. RECOMMENDATION Approval of the resolution. BACKGROUND The proposed Surface Transportation Program Grant is for the development of the Tri-Creek Greenway Trail Project, which is a twelve (12)-foot wide trail corridor in the center of City of Little Rock following Rock Creek, Fourche Creek, and Brodie Creek. The Greenway Trail System will connect several parks starting in Kanis Park connecting to Boyle Park, First Tee and the Animal Village, Western Hills Park, Hindman Park, and Brodie Park. The project would connect to existing trail infrastructure along Interstate 630.
