<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to execute a contract with Gametime for installation of a Gametime Superior Recreational Products Pavilion and a Gametime Powerscape Modular Playground Structure with accessible poured-in place rubber surfacing for Western Hills Park.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p>	<p>The cost of project is \$447,911.03, with contingency funding to not exceed \$515,000.00. Pavilion construction amount is \$119,742.08 and the playground construction amount is \$328,168.95. Funding will be provided by the Western Hills Park 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales Tax Funds, Account No. 326459-TS45A20, and the Legacy Grant Funds, Account No. 270459-G23147.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>Citizens in Western Hills Neighborhood and surrounding area have supported this project for many years and are excited to see forward movement towards completion of the development of a neighborhood park. Recently an Outdoor Legacy Grant was received in the amount of \$621,614 with the required City match of \$700,000 for a total budget for project of \$1.4 million for Western Hills Park.
